Born in New Zealand, and a former lecturer at the 'wine university' Plumpton College, Kevin Sutherland is the viticulturist and winemaker at Bluebell Vineyard Estates and helped establish the estate when it was founded in 2005. His background in horticulture has driven his desire to produce fruit-driven, distinctly fresh, vintage wines.

PERRIER JOUET GRAND BRUT

Champagne, France

Perrier Jouet carefully selects grapes from between 35 to 40 crus in the heart of the most prestigious sites in the Champagne region for its wines. The slope of the famous Cote des Blancs, is without a doubts the finest vineyard area in the Champagne district as it grows the best Chardonnay grapes. This Grand Marque house is right on song and displays lovely aromas and flavours of tropical fruits. A full citrus, spice and yeast fruit flavour dominate the front palate followed by elegance, complexity. Overall this has a fine, persistent mousse followed by lingering flavours of fresh apples and lemons. A delightfully crisp and balanced Champagne

LUGANA "Perla" NEW

Perla del Garda, Lombardia, Italy

This noble autochthonous Trebbiano di Lugana wine is typical of Lake Garda with its unique soil type rich in clay, has limited annual production. Straw yellow with greenish reflex, clean on the nose with perfumes of green apple, lime and wild thyme. Pleasant and soft on the palate.

CHARDONNAY "Morning Fog" (partially oaked)

Wente, Vineyards Livermore valley, California

The winery was established by Carl Wente in 1883 in the Livermore valley as one of the premier wine growing areas in California introducing first varietal wine label. The wine is dry with a beautiful straw colour and aromas of freshly cut apple, vanilla and citrus. The palate is smooth with stone fruit, citrus, toast and cream flavour from well integrated oak. It has a mouth filling body with a medium-long finish that is refreshing

SANCERRE "Les Longues Fins"

Domaine Andre Neveu, France

The Sauvignon blanc grape excels in this rich, limestone soils, giving a crisp edge to the wines natural richness. This single vineyards Sancerre has the added complexity of mineral and herbaceous flavour of gooseberries and blackcurrant and limes lingers on the finish

CHABLIS PREMIER CRU

Domaine Alain Gautheron, France

The Gautheron estate has been family owned for five generations making very traditional Chablis from 25ha of vineyard. Their Chablis offers fresh, floral aromas, apple fruit and complex, rich mineral character derived from subtle influence of the chalky vineyard soils. Fermentation and maturation is in vat to preserve the fresh steely flavours and lively balanced citrus finish

A bright salmon pink rose' made from the Groslot grape variety, grown on the gravel soils of the central Loire. It is a medium dry rose', the sweetness finely balanced with notes of summer fruits, strawberry, watermelon and hints of ripe peach. Well balanced and fresh with a crisp, clean acidity.

Full bodied, dry and rich but with soft and smooth tannins.

MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO

Famous wine from Abruzzo region rich ruby red with similar red fruit aromas and flavours on the palate. A nose and palate bursting with cherries and plums surrounded with a pleasant unassuming hint of spicy oak.

Smooth and wood-aged, with fruit flavours of blueberry and red cherry combine with round tannins and spice note to give a rich feel. Full bodied, yet very elegant. Among 17.000 win vega was voted #1 Best Buy for 2012 by the Wine Enthusiast magazine.

ROSSO TOSCANO "SIR PASSO" (Supertuscan)

Duca di Saragnano, Tuscany, Italy

Late-harvest, over ripe, dehydrated Sangiovese is the main innovative technique. The grapes have huge sugar content as it witnessed by its 15% of alcohol combined with the extraordinary chocolate black cherry bitter-sweetness of the wine. Fruit character is that of black cherries, which though very ripe are kept fresh by Sangiovese's natural acidity and that individual almond note on the back of the finish. Sangiovese like you have never tasted before!

RIOJA "Edición Limitada"

Bodegas Ramon Bilbao, Rioja, Spain

Made from 40 years old Tempranillo vines, then is fermented in large oak barrel and matured in barrique for 14 months a further 9 months in bottle. An intense dark garnet colour with aromas of fresh red berry, plum and cherry followed by oak & smoked notes on the palate with well structured tannins & long balanced finish.

SHIRAZ "Paulett's"

Paulett's wines, Clare Valley, Australia

Aromas of blackberry, plum & chocolate are given an element of spice from 18 months maturation in American oak barrel. It is a powerful Shiraz, richly flavoured with candied fruits, game & mineral nuances, long & satisfying

MALBEC RESERVA "Fianca Sopenia" £ 27,95

Mendoza, Argentina

This lightly oaked Malbec has an intense deep colour with violet hues. Complex aromas of plums and ripe cherries and violets. It is enhanced by the presence of dry fruits and mint hints. A wine of great concentration, showing sweet and voluminous tannins and wonderful complexity. It has won Gold medal at San Francisco International Wine competition.

VALPOLICELLA RIPASSO "Corte Giona" £ 28,95

Tenute Salvaterra, Veneto, Italy

A subtle and wonderfully charismatic cherry scented red wine, given an extraordinary depth of flavour by refermenting the blend of Valpolicella grape varieties on the skin left from the Amarone wine and matured for 18 months in large oak barrels. The wine shows a spicy pepper nose, with a hint of raisins. Intense, spicy and sweet cherry flavours abound on the palate, a well balanced wine.

CHIANTI CLASSICO RISERVA "Forziere" £ 29,95

Tenute Sensi, Tuscany, Italy

It is Chianti selected according to its special properties of excellence. It is aged two years in oak barrels and refined in bottle. The deep ruby-red colour with orange shades, the intense long-lasting bouquet and the mature full taste, respect the great Tuscan tradition of wine production.

BAROLO "Poiane" £ 31,50

Cascina Radice, Piedmont, Italy

Near the town of Barolo in the rolling hills of Piedmont, where vineyards have long been famous for producing some of Italy's very finest red wines - predominantly from the region's signature grape variety, Nebbiolo. This wine has been aged 3 years in Slovenian oaks followed by 12 months in bottle. Ruby red in colour, it is fully bodied, robust but velvety and harmonious.

PINOT NOIR "Wairau River" £ 35,00

Wairau River, Marlborough, New Zealand

Wairau River is one of the largest independent wine estate in Marlborough, and the range of elegant wines is characteristically expressive of its Marlborough roots. The wine shows aromas of cherry and wild berry fruits, shadowed by supple oak, whilst the palate is soft and generous, showing true varietal flavours.

RIOJA GRAN RESERVA "Ramon Bilbao" £ 38,00

Bodegas Ramon Bilbao, Haro, Spain

Harvested from old vines this Rioja wine is aged for 30 months in American oak casks, followed by a further 36 months ageing in the cellar. It has deep ruby red, bonfire aromas are followed by stewed fruit and spices on the palate. Well structured and harmonious on the finish.

NEGROAMARO "Emozione" £ 42,95

Vinicola Mediterranea, Apulia, Italy

Deep ruby red colour with violet highlights. Intense and fragrant bouquet with a rich variety of ripe fruits, pleasant, harmonious and velvety taste. It goes well with roasted or grilled meats. Ideal with stuffed goose and game. Excellent with hard aged cheese.

WHITE WINES

POUILLY FUISSE

'Les Crays', Domaine Auvigue, France

Jean Auvigue produces Pouilly Fuisse' of the highest quality with vibrant Chardonnay fruit. The palate is complex with a clean minerality, while a brief maturation in wooden cask adds toast, vanilla and sweet spice to the rich apple flavours. A blend of both stainless steel and oak cask fermentation helps to capture the classic **terroir** and delicious rich ripe flavours that are unique to these vineyards.

POUILIGNY MONTRACHET

Domaine Jean Pascal, France

This small family Domain, which was founded in 1920 in Puligny-Montrachet and is now, owned by Jean-Luc Pascal, on the outskirts of the village of Puligny embodies meticulous traditional winemaking with minimal use of oak. Folatieres in this wine is as close as you can get to the grand cru wines of Le Montrachet and it really demonstrates why they are that much more expensive. Supremely fine and elegant with notes of white peach, cream and a distinctive, flinty minerality and fruit levels well beyond a village wine.

RED WINES

BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO

Antinori, Tuscany, Italy

The king of Italian wine, dry, warm and well textured with a lingering bouquet reminiscent of liquorice, raspberry and vanilla through to a firm finish. Pure Sangiovese from a selection of the grapes of our vineyard matured in 30hl Slavonian oak barrels for 36 months with subsequent ageing of four months in the bottle.

AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA RISERVA "Cave di Prun"

Tenute Salvaterra, Veneto, Italy

This is a very refined Amarone with great balance and infinite elegance and thanks to his structure and extract it will be able to improve with the passage of the years. Dark ruby colour with a very slight gamet edge: an intense and very complex perfume with dominant notes of raisins, cherries and prunes with hints of vanilla violets and cinnamon, Full, generous and firm with an elegant and persistent aftertaste of jam and spices.

TIGNANELLO ANTINORI

Antinori, Tuscany, Italy

Antinori is the most famous name in Italian wine and the influence of Piero Antinori in the last 25 years has been nothing short of revolutionary. Antinori's flagship wine, Tignanello first appeared in 1971 and caused a sensation by its use of Cabernet Sauvignon in a Sangiovese blend and with its practise of ageing ins small French barriques. The wine's characteristic power has been joined by a new sense of grace, with notes of violet and liquorice complementing the red fruit and toasty oak aromas. The palate is sleek and seamless even in its youth, aiming for length over breadth.
